We will be charging \$10 for breakfast items, water, soda, and coffee. We will break after 9 games for a 60 minute lunch period. Lorna is making her world-famous chili, so it will be a potluck lunch. There are also multiple restaurants in the vicinity should you wish to go out to eat. Feel free to bring a dish! Please inform either Lorna or myself on what you would like to bring. Something that goes well with chili would be ideal.

BREAKDOWN:

Adult ACC Fee: \$20 (If you are playing unofficially, then it is \$8)

Youth ACC Fee: \$8

\$10 Fee for soda, water, donuts and coffee.

\$15 Fee: Top Finishers Pots. (payout will be a ratio of 1:4) - (12 players - pay 3 spots, 16 players - pay 4 spots, etc.)

In addition to the payout of the Top Finishers Pots,

Top Player First 9 Games will receive \$5

Top Player Second 9 Games will receive \$5

Top Player of the Day will receive \$15

\$20 Fee: Sidepots (\$2 per pool x 5 pots x 2 sessions = \$20)

- 1) 24 Hand
- 2) High Skunk
- 3) Crib Flush
- 4) 4 of a Kind
- 5) High Score Hand and Crib (28 point minimum to qualify)

First 9 Games: \$2 per player for each of the 5 categories (\$10)

Second 9 Games: \$2 per player for each of the 5 categories (\$10)

Notes:

This is an 18-game tournament. We need to keep games moving at a good pace. Games should be completed in 15-17 minutes. It's understood that a game here and there might take a couple minutes longer because of bad hands, but in general games should not drag out because of slow play and slow counting.

In order to keep things easy on me, you are either in all the side pots or out.

- Payouts are rounded down to the whole dollar
- Any unclaimed pots will be subject to a random drawing to determine the winner.
- Multiple claims on side pots will be divided equally, or rounded down to the whole dollar.

YOU MUST BE IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE ACC AND GRASS ROOTS DUES MUST BE CURRENT IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS TOURNAMENT.

For any discrepancies during play, PLEASE call for a judge to come over for a ruling.
