### **Driving Directions:**

From Clinton ferry dock head north on Hwy. 20 for 34 miles. Turn right on Sidney St. Cell Phone: Club house is .2 miles on right. Must leave the Mukilteo dock no later than 8:00AM sailing to arrive on time

Tournament registration and tournament set-up will start at 9:00 AM. Seating will be assigned by random card drawing. Play will start promptly at 9:30 AM or as soon as everyone is seated and instructions/announcements are completed. Tournament play of 18 games will be governed by ACC rules. Participants are expected to complete a game in about 15 to 20 minutes maximum. If a player typically takes 5 minutes longer to play a game than other participants, lunch will delayed by about 45 minutes for everyone and the tournament will complete about an hour and a half behind schedule.
