ABOUT THE ACC

The American Cribbage Congress, established 1980, is a non-profit organization dedicated to Making the game of cribbage fun and fair for people of all ages. To this end, the Congress sponsors over 150 sanctioned tournaments each year all over the country. They award \$100 for 29-hand scored in sanctioned play as well as certificates for 28-hands. Standard rules and scoring system have been established with players earning points for their performances through out the season. The ACC season runs from August 1 through July 31 and the player Scoring the most points in a season is crowned National Champion.

Statistics are recorded and each year there are lifetime awards presented to those who have attained 2000 lifetime points, honored as a Master, 4000 points earns Grand Master, 6.000 are needed for Life Master status. Beyond that we have Life Master star rating awarded to those with 10,000 master points. Players will receive additional awards for each 5000 points they will earn another star. As a member you will receive a monthly Magazine called Cribbage World that keeps you up to date with what's going on in the ACC, tournaments around the country, schedules and point standings as well as all the news to keep us informed. The ACC has an Internet Cribbage Tournament program where individuals from around the world can play on line in organized tournaments. So, if you're looking a place to play cribbage, you've come to the right place. The ACC is the home of great CRIBBAGE!

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

ACC membership is \$15/year for a single member or \$18/year for couples. This includes membership and a monthly subscription to <u>Cribbage World</u> which contains information about playing tips, and tournament results as well as future tournaments in the country and standings in the three regions of the organization.

TOURNAMENT RULES

GRASS ROOTS CLUB 72

WELCOME!

Dealing: If the pone exposes a card during deal, the cards shall be re-dealt. DO NOT pick up the cards until dealer has completed the distribution of them

Pegging: After completing the first series toward 31, cards may not be turned over. When the fingers are taken off the peg, the pegging is complete. In case of pegging short of the mark, the points are lost. If you peg in the wrong direction, peg stays where placed. Take up your front peg and it does become your back peg and points are lost. There are many rules that may be different than the type of cribbage you are playing now, and it will take some practice to get accustomed to them, and for this reason the Grass Roots program is recommended before you play in tournaments.

You will be welcome and we will be very happy to teach you the rules of our play.
